Blood Heart

Maths

The children will be introduced to ratio and the associated language. They will develop their knowledge of algebra and use simple two-step rules and equations.
Children will learn how to work out percentages and link this to their knowledge of decimals and fractions.

English

The children will continue to develop their use of descriptive language and dialogue in a story opening for Macbeth. They will look at rhyming couplets and create their own for the witches' spell. To finish the term, the children will focus on journalistic writing. They will then use their geography work as a starting point for a report on a natural disaster.

Computing

Apply spreadsheet modelling to data from PE. Use formula to generate data in cells. Learn how to format and use the sigma button.

Art

The children will be completing a textiles unit, where they will look at how artists use collage to create landscapes. The children will create their own collage using a range of fabrics.

Any donations of scrap fabrics/old clothes (blue, black, grey and white) would be greatly appreciated.

Science

The children will identify and name the main parts of the human circulatory system and describe the functions of the heart, blood vessels and blood. They will recognise the impact of diet, exercise, drugs and lifestyle on the way their body functions. They will conduct experiments and tests to show the effect of different activities on pulse and breathing rate.

PE

Fitness - developing speed, stamina, agility, strength and an awareness of their own physical capabilities.
Tag rugby - a team strategy game.

Music

Listening to and appraising music from across history.

PSHE/Jigsaw - 'Healthy Me'

Children will learn about how making healthy and non-healthy choices can impact them.

RE - Believing

What do religions say to us when life gets hard?

Geography

The children will build on their previous learning about where and why volcanoes and earthquakes occur. They will focus on the impact of natural disasters on humans.

French

Children will learn how to say countries and continents and describe their location in the world.
