

YEAR 1 WRITING

To be WORKING all of the statements must be secure

Can form most letters clearly, although size and shape may be irregular.

Always leaves spaces between words.

Begins to make phonetic attempts at words.

Can spell CVC words (consonant, vowel, consonant e.g. sit / bag / cat) usually correctly.

Need to be working securely within this band and have achieved ALL RED statements to be SECURE.

Can spell all the words on Year 1 list in the N.C. Appendix 1).

Can demarcate some sentences with capital letters.

Can demarcate some sentences with full stops.

Is beginning to use question marks.

Can write a series of simple sentences on the same subject, most of which make sense.

Need to be working securely within this band and have achieved ALL YELLOW statements to be SECURE +

Can spell some common exception words.

Can write simple sentences that are sequenced to form a short narrative (real or fictional).

Can demarcate most sentences with capital letters and full stops.

Uses spacing between words that reflects the size of the letters.

Can form lower-case letters in the correct direction, starting and finishing in the right place.

Can use ANY conjunction (may be only ever be 'and') to join two simple sentences.
