Dear Parents,

This term we will be learning all about dragons through our topic 'Dungeons, Dragons and Drawbridges'. We will continue to complete daily Maths, Reading, Writing and Phonics lessons. In addition to this, we have also planned a range of topic activities, details of which can be found on the attached topic web. Towards the end of the term, we will be taking part in our Geography fieldwork which will include a walk to Abbey Meads Village Centre where we will build on learning from Year 1 and carry out a survey.

In Term 5, the spellings, number bond and times tables systems will continue to run as in the previous terms. If you have questions about any of these, please do speak to your class teacher.

Reading will continue to be a major focus and we expect all children to be reading for ten minutes every day at home. We also expect this to be recorded in their reading record and signed by an adult. Children who have progressed beyond the coloured phonic phase books now have logins and passwords for Accelerated Reader. These have been stuck in the front of their reading records. Once children have finished reading their book, they can take the online quiz to earn points and certificates. Please speak to your class teacher if you have any questions about this new system.

This term, children will have their PE sessions on a Tuesday and Thursday. Please ensure your child wears appropriate kit on these days. Long hair will need to be tied back and earrings must be covered with tape or removed.
