

Maths

Place value and the four operations.
Using and applying known knowledge and skills to a range of problems.

English

Children will create a travel brochure for the Isle of Wight showing a clear awareness of their audience. They will write poetry using figurative language. They will look at the features of persuasive texts and use this to persuade others to attend the residential. The children will also write an extra chapter for our class books, showing awareness of character and atmosphere.

Computing

Children will look at how the internet facilitates online communication and collaboration and complete shared projects online. Children will develop their knowledge and understanding of using a computer to produce 3D models.
