## Christmas and Covid -

You will all be aware that the various Christmas Nativities and Year 1 Songs are scheduled to have live audiences this year. This situation remains subject to levels of Covid-19 cases, within our school, and may be cancelled for parents at short notice. We will do our best to film the performances if this must happen.

Parents of children in Acorn, Hazel, Beech, 1Alder, 1Birch, 2Chestnut and 2Hornbeam will receive letters with further information regarding their performances, the time and the allocation of tickets by Monday. For all performances you are allocated a maximum of 2 tickets per child, for the time set specifically for your child's class. **You MUST bring the tickets** to the performance and, to control numbers, **you will only be allowed to attend the correct performance.**

We will also be asking everyone to help us avoid having to isolate over our holidays, by following some basic rules and where possible some simple requests:

- 1) You must not attend if you have any symptoms of Covid, should be isolating or are feeling unwell.
- 2) You must wear a mask when on site (unless you are formally exempt)
- 3) You should only attend the performance for your child's class - do not try and attend a different performance, you will not be allowed to attend.
- 4) It would help if you were prepared to carry out an LFD test before attending, to prove you are negative at that time. We will not request QR codes or 'Covid passports' but do ask that you all help us stay safe and well (and avoid having to isolate all through your Christmas) by doing this for us.

**Thursday 16th December - Christmas Lunch Day** - those not having a School Christmas Lunch will need to bring a packed lunch. Don't be fooled by the menu on ParentPay - it is Christmas Dinner on 16/12/21. Our final assembly of the year will be **Thursday 16th December (our last day of term)** where we will share our final Golden Book moment and sing some carols. *There will not be a Carol Service this year.*
