Dear Parents

Welcome back to term 6! We hope that you had a lovely break and are ready for our final term of the year. To start off our term, we will be having a special week to help celebrate and commemorate the Queen's Platinum Jubilee. During this week, we will be learning about the Queen and the royal family, some important events during the Queen's life as well as the types of toys the Queen, her children and grandchildren would have played with and compare these with our toys today.

For the rest of the term, our topic will be entitled 'Ready, Steady, Cook!'. Over the coming weeks we will be exploring different fruits and vegetables and using these to create snacks for our end of term picnic. In English, we will be exploring and writing instructions in the form of recipes linked to our food work in DT. We will also continue to focus on using correct punctuation as well as adjectives and conjunctions in their writing. In Maths we will be working on simple fractions, money and time as well as consolidation work on number and place value. In preparation for Year 2, we will also be completing weekly times tables quizzes on the 2, 5 and 10 times tables.

At home we would really appreciate your continued support with your child's reading, spellings and number bonds.

- **Spellings** will continue to be sent out on a Friday. It is important that the children practise reading and writing these words at home to embed their learning at school from the week.
- **Number bonds** will also be assessed on a Tuesday. Children will need to get 9 or 10/10 three times in a row before they are moved on.
- Please continue to **read** with your child each evening for 10-15 minutes and note in their Reading Record book when you have done this.

This term, our indoor PE session will take place on a Thursday and our outdoor PE session will take place on a Tuesday. Please ensure your child has a full PE kit in school at all times. This will need to include daps or trainers suitable for outdoor PE.
