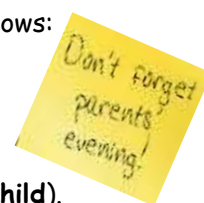
Virtual Appointments

If you book a virtual appointment, you will receive a link to the video call 24 hours before your chosen session time. At the time of your appointment, click on the link and a window will open in your web browser and this is where the video call will take place. You then need to click on "Join Call" at your session time. You will have a 10-minute appointment with your child's teacher but when this time has elapsed, the video call will stop automatically. There is a counter at the bottom of the screen, so you know how much time you have remaining, and this will turn red when you have 30 seconds left.

Face to Face Appointments

You will have a 10-minute appointment with your child's teacher. The teachers always try to keep to time to avoid people waiting but **we need your help and would appreciate it if you could also keep to the times you have chosen**. Please do not feel offended if the teacher explains that your 10 minutes has come to an end.

Children are welcome, but we discourage all siblings coming along to the appointment.

On Thursday, Year 2 enjoyed visiting the STEAM Museum in Swindon. Here they took part in an educational workshop about Brunel to support their learning of local history. Disassembling and rebuilding the wooden trains and bridges were particular highlights, and the children's learning came to life through the Victorian hats and outfits they could try on. Children explored the interactive exhibits at the museum, and it was incredible to board the old-fashioned train carriages and see underneath one of the trains. The children finished their trip with a guided coach trip through Swindon to Old Town Gardens. Through this, children could celebrate and grow knowledgeable in local geography specific to them, building on their sense of community and identity.
