We have a position in our kitchen come available. It is for 26.5 hours a week at £9.62 hr.

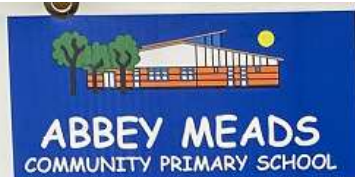
Pay likely to increase shortly due to Support Staff pay awards.
