

Year 4 Writing

To be WORKING all of the statements must be secure (green)

Can punctuate a paragraph of writing correctly with full stops and question marks and exclamation marks are used correctly.

Can show awareness of the purpose of a piece of writing.

Can make sure that most of a piece of writing makes sense.

Need to be working securely within this band and have achieved ALL RED statements to be SECURE.

Using paragraphs correctly in some writing.

Can use pronouns, nouns and tenses accurately and consistently throughout.

Can use a wider range of punctuation, almost always accurately:

capital letters for new sentences and proper nouns

apostrophe for contraction

exclamation mark for interjection and commands

inverted commas

Can link and relate events, including past, present and future, sensibly, (afterwards, before, also, after a while,

Can spell accurately all of the Year 3/4 words in the N.C. Appendix 1.

Can use both coordinating and subordinating conjunctions.

Need 2 Statements from below and ALL of the above (Yellow and Red) to be SECURE+

Can use an apostrophe for possession.

Can use commas to demarcate clauses.

Can write neatly, legibly and accurately, maintaining a joined style.

Can use a range of cohesive devices including adverbials within and across a range of sentences and paragraphs, e.g. to show time and cause.

Can integrate descriptions of setting and characters within longer pieces of writing.
