Virtual Appointments

If you book a virtual appointment, you will receive a link to the video call **24 hours before** your chosen session time. At the time of your appointment, click on the link and a window will open in your web browser and this is where the video call will take place. You then need to click on "Join Call" at your session time. You will have a 10-minute appointment with your child's teacher but when this time has elapsed, **the video call will stop automatically**. There is a counter at the bottom of the screen, so you know how much time you have remaining, and this will turn red when you have 30 seconds left.

Face to Face Appointments

You will have a 10-minute appointment with your child's teacher. The teachers always try to keep to time to avoid people waiting but **we need your help and would appreciate it if you could also keep to the times you have chosen**. Please do not feel offended if the teacher explains that your 10 minutes has come to an end.

Children are welcome, but we discourage all siblings coming along to the appointment.


School Council Elections Next Week
