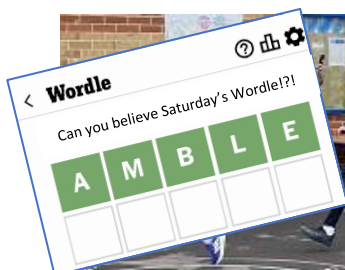
Visiting places of worship is an integral part of our RE curriculum, so we use this opportunity to visit one in our local community.

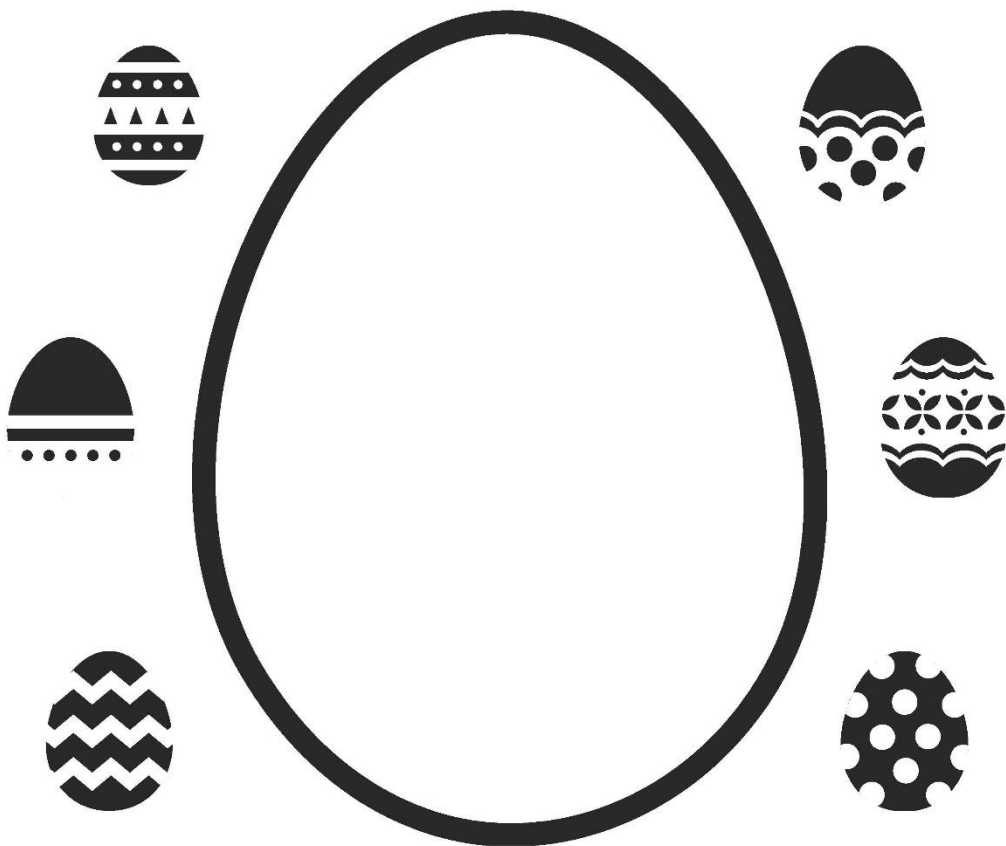
